HOW TO MEASURE COLOUR - NOT MORE THAN 5% OF BODY

Colour acceptable – not more than 5%: Use this diagram to help calculate percentage of excess colour over the shoulders and coming down onto the legs



Previous colour guidelines.

- Colour on front and chest area not extending down onto legs or over withers
- Only one patch with a maximum of 10 cm in diameter is permitted on the barrel, hindquarter and belly
- Patches of 5cm in diameter are permitted on legs. No mottle colouring allowed.
- Coloured tail but red cannot continue onto the body for more than 2.5 cm.

The following photos are all acceptable in the Australian Breed Standard and meet the requirements of allowed colour. Please note this is only a representation of colour and not limited to these. More photos will be included as they come to hand.
