Animals over 12 months old to be Registered
2. All animals to have a negative CAE & JD test with 12 months of the Show. Kids under 12 months to go by Dams Certificate.
Certificate to be sent with entries.
3. Exhibitors to fill in an Animal Health Form and associated Waybills to attend Show.
4. Animals to be tattooed as per DGSA Regulations or have an electronic ear tag
5. Goatling, Buckling over 12 months & under 2years
6. Adult Buck, over 2 years
7. Doe or Buck Kid, under 12 months.

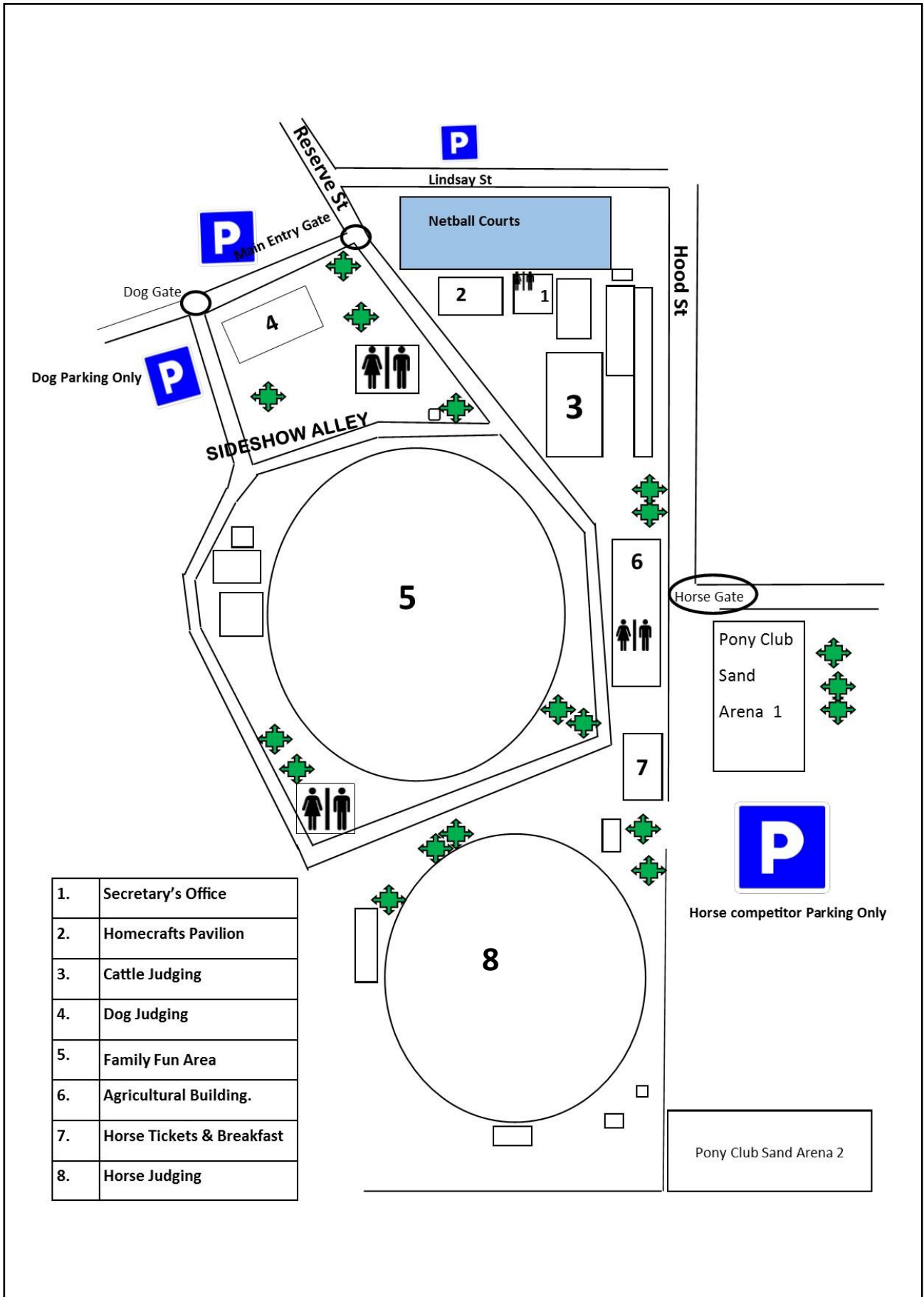
