- 3. Exhibitors to fill in an Animal Health Form and associated Waybills to attend Show.
- 4. Animals to be tattooed as per DGSA Regulations or have an electronic ear tag
- 5. Goatling, Buckling over 12 months & under 2years
- 6. Adult Buck, over 2 years
- 7. Doe or Buck Kid, under 12 months.


